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If you have an outstanding balance that is past due, an additional contribution of up to the same per-pay-period amount as your current coverage will be deducted from your pay until your outstanding past-due balance is zero. If you are no longer enrolled in coverage, a flat amount of up to \$125 per pay period will be deducted from your pay until your outstanding past-due balance is zero.
